Even though the Board deemed Ms Olufunke Ighodaro and Mr Mteto Nyati to be independent on the matter; Ms Olufunke Ighodaro recused herself from the discussion given her role as lead independent director of Massmart Holdings. Consequently both Mr Nyati and Ms Ighodaro resigned from the Massmart Board.  Massmart Holdings Ltd delisted from the JSE with effect from 22 November 2022.
